



LRSO 2009-2010 Concerto Competition Overview

The Meredith, NH-based Lakes Region Symphony Orchestra, now in its 34th year, is pleased to announce our **first annual concerto competition for young artists** in the Lakes Region. The goal of the competition is to identify talented young classical musicians and encourage their musical advancement while providing an opportunity to perform with a Symphony Orchestra.

Laconia Harley-Davidson is the proud sponsor of this competition.

Students will be competing for the opportunity to play as a soloist with the Lakes Region Symphony Orchestra in November 2010 at Inter-Lakes Auditorium in Meredith, NH, as well as a \$200 cash prize. The competition is open to high school students who play an orchestral instrument in grades 9-11. The student must select and record a movement (preferably the first, or a fast movement) of a concerto from the standard orchestral repertoire.

Applications are due December 31, 2009; Recordings are due February 15, 2010. If applicable, the student will be invited to the second round, which is playing in person for a committee of adjudicators in the spring of 2010.
